

Good Morning,

I hope this email finds you well and that you and your families had a restful and well-deserved spring break. As we enter April, we are actively continuing our preparations at Chardon High School for the upcoming AIR tests. Once again, students will take the end of course exams on the assigned date if they meet the criteria defined below.

- Freshmen or sophomore student enrolled in English Language Arts 1 or 2
- Freshmen or sophomore student enrolled in Algebra 1 or Geometry
- Sophomore students enrolled in U.S. History
- Seniors enrolled in 2nd Semester US Government
- Sophomores who have been notified by their guidance counselor that they must take the biology test to replace their physical science score from last year.
***Note: This an extremely small number of students. ONLY students notified by their guidance counselor will be taking the biology test this year. If you were not notified, your student will not be taking the biology test this year.*

We previously communicated the testing dates to you via connect-ed message. On the designated days, students will report to their assigned testing classroom that will be clearly posted in the school building. **It is imperative that your student is at school on time on their assigned testing day.** Once again, the assigned testing dates are...

- 4/13-Biology (**No late start**)
- 4/20-English Language Arts 1/English Language Arts 2
- 4/27-US History/ US Government
- 5/4-Algebra 1/Geometry

The **late start bell schedule** for **4/20** will be as follows. The state mandated testing time for this day is 3.5 hours. Please note that testing will begin **promptly at 7:30 AM.**

Please Note: Transportation will run at normal times on testing days. If a student **is not** testing on a particular day and needs transportation to school, they will be picked up at the normal time and report to school. We will supervise these students in the cafeteria until the regular school day begins.

Student Example 1: (A freshman student enrolled in algebra 1 and English 1). *This student will report to CHS at the normal time on April 20th and May 4th for math and English testing. They are not required to report to school until 10:25 AM on April 27th since they will not be taking the Social Studies test.*

Student Example 2: (A senior student currently enrolled in 2nd semester US Govt. **not 1st semester US Govt.**) *This student will report to CHS at the normal time on April 27th for testing. They are not required to report to school until 10:25 AM on 4/20 and 5/4 since they are not testing on those dates.*

Thank you for your patience and attention to detail as we continue our preparations for the upcoming AIR tests. ***When students report to school for their assigned test they will be required to bring their chromebook fully charged as well as a pair of headphones.*** We will provide extra sets of headphones if students are unable to procure them. We will continue to pass along relevant information to you as the testing dates approach.
