2015-2016 SCHOOL PROFILE

Chardon High School (CHS) is a four-year, comprehensive public high school located in Chardon, Ohio. Chardon is located 30 miles east of Cleveland in a suburban/rural community consisting of Middle/Upper Middle class families. Current enrollment is 1,025 students: 93% Caucasian with a gender breakdown of 51% male and 49% female.

Chardon offers a vast array of high level courses including 15 Advanced Placement courses, Independent Study/Credit Flex options, and partnerships with local colleges to offer students College Credit Plus opportunities. Also, for the first time at CHS, students will have the ability to earn college credit through dual enrollment courses. Students enrolled in AP Biology, AP Chemistry, and AP Physics will be eligible to earn up to 23 college credits for successful completion of these courses.

Chardon High School is also a member of the Auburn Career Center Joint Vocational Consortium and a member of the North Central Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools.

Continuing with a 1:1 technology initiative, Chardon will grow a blended learning environment for all students. Students and teachers have the ability to integrate the use of technology and learning within the classroom with access to real-time classroom feedback through Google Classroom, online learning, collaborative projects, and academic supports through the use of Chromebooks. Chardon HS has also expanded their technology department this year with the addition of a Technology Integration Specialist to offer new, technology related electives during the 2nd semester.

Ohio Graduation Requirements dictate that students must complete 20 credit hours, including 4 years of English and 4 years of Mathematics to earn a diploma. Students may earn an Honors Diploma by meeting additional criteria. Students are graded on a 4.000 scale, all courses being un-weighted, and rankings based upon overall GPA.

College Prep Honors Diploma

Students can earn a College Prep Honors Diploma by completing 7 of 8 requirements below.

1. 4 units English
2. 4 units Math (including Alg. II and 1 Higher course)
3. 4 units Science (including Chemistry and Physics)
4. 4 units Social Studies
5. 3 units Foreign Language (or 2 units of each)
6. 1 unit Fine Arts
7. 3.500 Cumulative GPA
8. 27 on ACT or 1210 SAT (Verbal/Math)

The Class of 2014 graduated 82 students (31 %) with a College Prep Honors Diploma.

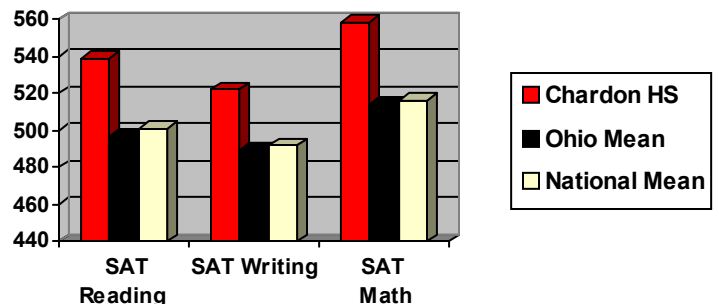
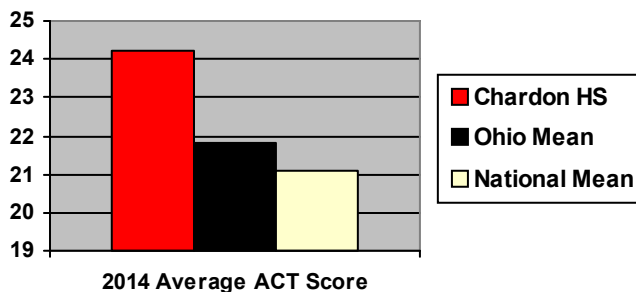

College Testing Statistics

Chardon High School students have demonstrated a strong dedication to outstanding academic performance. Our students have consistently outperformed the Ohio and National averages on the ACT and all content areas of the SAT exams. Chardon High School scored an average ACT score of 24.2 and earned a Silver Medal from US News and World Report as one of *America's Top High Schools* in 2014. Chardon High School was also recognized by Newsweek as one of *America's Top High Schools* in 2013.

Current enrollment indicates that 16 % of the eligible student population is enrolled in 1 or more Advanced Placement courses. In 2014, over 290 Advanced Placement Tests were given to students, a 32% increase from 2013.
