During the last week of school, student in grades 8-11 will report to school each period. The only sections that are not mandatory to report to is study hall, and a few already assessed mixed courses/ End of Course Exam Grade Equivalent Eligible Students. All study halls will be supervised as regularly scheduled. Breakfast will only be served during exam week. Furthermore, transportation will run at regular times for those students that need morning and afternoon transportation. All students in grades 8-11 will either be in class for the end of the year closure activities, project presentations, tests for the quarter, or final examinations. The school day begins at the regularly scheduled times, and concludes at 11:45 AM. The time placed aside for these courses allows each student to best prepare for last classes with their teacher for this quarter. There are some very important reminders to how grades are assessed for the end of the year:

GRADING DETERMINATIONS

The purpose of grades is to clearly, accurately, consistently, and fairly communicate learning progress and achievement with students, families, postsecondary institutions, and prospective employers. Chardon High School will help students build a strong academic identity and foster social responsibility in the high school setting.

Final course grades will be calculated by percentages, not letter grades.
